



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

ACTS 18:1-17

1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. How do you see your job/school/life as a mission field? What are you doing to share the gospel with those in your sphere of influence?
3. Why is it important to evaluate if you have godly friends who encourage you in the faith? Would you say your friends encourage you to pursue Jesus or not? Explain.
4. What are some characteristics of good gospel friends? Why are these friendships a grace in our lives?
5. When was the last time you saw gospel fruit in your life? When was the last time you saw gospel fruit in someone else's life? How does God use gospel fruit to encourage us?
6. What truths from Acts 18:9-10 can we hold onto during difficult times? How will those truths impact you this week?
7. Do you believe that God has people in our city who are not currently believers but will believe the gospel one day? If you answered yes, what keeps you from being faithful and sharing the gospel? What does Paul teach us in Romans 10:8-17 about the gospel and sharing?
8. What comfort can we take from Acts 18:12-17? How does God's sovereignty inform how we think about difficult events in our own lives?
9. What passages of Scripture comfort you in times of difficulty? Share them and consider memorizing a new passage this week.
10. How have you seen the Lord orchestrate events in your own life? Are you taking advantage of the opportunities to advance the gospel or for your own comfort?
