- 2. What are some of the surprising elements of John 13:1-20 for you?
- 3. What does the phrase "knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was going back to God" have to do with Jesus' act of foot washing?
- 4. Do you relate to Peter in this passage? What would your reaction have been if you had been reclining at the table with Jesus that night?
- 5. Do you believe v. 14 should be taken literally or symbolically? Why?
- 6. What are some obstacles to following Jesus' example of self-sacrificial love today?
- 7. What are some other places in the Gospels where Jesus models self-sacrificial love?
- 8. What does Jesus' victory over Satan, sin, and death mean for your life?
- 9. What practical ways can you participate in "foot washing" this week?
- 10. Where do you need your Connect Group's encouragement to follow Jesus this week?
