3. What, if anything, keeps you from consistently sharing the gospel with others?
4. How did Paul's observations of idolatry in Athens fuel his desire to share the gospel clearly?
5. What observations can you make about idolatry in Dacula and Gwinnett, and how can those observations be used to fuel your sharing of the gospel in our city and county?
6. In the sight line and shadow of the Greek Parthenon, what courage do you think it took for Paul to stand on the Areopagus and share about Christ?
7. What can we learn about how Paul shared the gospel in Athens that would be helpful in our sharing of the gospel?
8. What authority does God have to command all people everywhere to repent? Why is the command to repent ultimately a kindness toward us?
9. How are you striving to see that all people in all places have an opportunity to hear the gospel?
10. How can we not let those who reject the gospel impact our joy and perseverance in sharing the gospel?
