- 5. What observations can you make about idolatry in Dacula and Gwinnett, and how can those observations be used to fuel your sharing of the gospel in our city and county?
- 6. In the sight line and shadow of the Greek Parthenon, what courage do you think it took for Paul to stand on the Areopagus and share about Christ?
- 7. What can we learn about how Paul shared the gospel in Athens that would be helpful in our sharing of the gospel?
- 8. What authority does God have to command all people everywhere to repent? Why is the command to repent ultimately a kindness toward us?
- 9. How are you striving to see that all people in all places have an opportunity to hear the gospel?
- 10. How can we not let those who reject the gospel impact our joy and perseverance in sharing the gospel?
