1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. Give an example of a time that you were dedicated to God's Will, even when His Will was not easy. What did you learn from that experience?
3. How do you discern God's Will in different circumstances? What role do God's Word, God's Spirit, and His Church play in your discernment?
4. How do you react when something happens, and you dislike it? What does this passage teach us about God's Will and circumstances? What does this passage teach us about God?
5. What role does Christian community play in Paul's life as he follows God's Will? How does Paul prioritize fellowship while maintaining dedication to God's Will? How do you maintain Christian community as you seek to follow God's Will?
6. What are you doing to seek out Christian community? How are you helping others see the value of Christian community?
7. Why does following God's Will usually require sacrifice?
8. How do you think about suffering as you follow God's Will? How should we find courage during suffering?
9. Why do you think some people doubt being in God's Will if they are experiencing suffering? How would you respond to someone who says that suffering means you are not in God's Will?
10. Are you resolved to advance the gospel, no matter the cost? What can you do this week to advance the gospel? With whom are you sharing? For whom are you praying?
