1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. What do you think could have tempted Joshua not to courageously obey God's commands? What tempts you not to courageously obey God?
3. How is it comforting that God does not ask us to find courage within ourselves, but fuels our courage by His presence, power, and promises?
4. Why is courage ultimately faith in the promised strength of God?
5. As you consider God's presence and power, when is a time you felt He empowered your obedience to something He was calling you to do?
6. Why is disobedience to God ultimately caused by disbelief in and of God?
7. In what ways are you following God's plan for your life as revealed in the Great Commandment and Great Commission?
8. In what ways is your gospel courage currently being fueled because of rejoicing in His presence? Why is it important to remember that God is not just for us but with us?
9. How are you striving to meditate on God's Word throughout the day and to carefully obey it?
10. What can we do to make sure God's Word is constantly coming out in our conversations?
11. In God's grace and power, how will you strive to make disciples this week?
12. What, if anything, can we pray for you to have courage about in obedience to the Lord?
