- 2. How is Christ's call to "Take Courage" ultimately a call to take comfort in Christ?
- 3. How can we be encouraged by Christ's affirming the facts Paul had been sharing about Jesus? Why should this strengthen our belief in the gospel?
- 4. When is a time you felt particularly comforted and strengthened by Christ as you were striving to serve Him?
- 5. As we serve the Lord, why should we expect passionate opposition from some in the world?
- 6. How can you see God's providence in Paul's nephew's learning of the plot and the process of communicating that information to the Roman tribune?
- 7. How have you seen God's providence working for your good as you serve Christ?
- 8. What does the large contingent of Roman soldiers who are assigned to escort Paul safely to Caesarea ultimately say to us about God?
- 9. How can the Spirit use Acts 23:11-35 in our heads and hearts to minimize worry and maximize worship of Christ?
- 10. In what ways, if any, are you failing to fully surrender to the Lord's plan for your life?
