- 2. When is a time you found waiting on God's timing to be difficult? In what ways were you tempted to confusion or concern?
- 3. How has the Lord empowered contentment in your life as you've waited on His plans?
- 4. How has the Lord used waiting to further conform you to the image of Christ?
- 5. Is there anything for which you are currently waiting on the Lord for direction, guidance, or next steps?
- 6. Why is unrighteous anger a waste of time? Why can it be so tempting and timeconsuming?
- 7. As we serve the Lord, how should we handle unrighteous accusations and "ambushes" used against us?
- 8. How can we minimize being tempted to cower in appeasement to those aligned against Christ? What are ways you are tempted to appease the "crowd" in your life rather than following Christ?
- 9. How can we know and trust that God is working at all times for our good and His glory?
- 10. How can we utilize legal and political processes available to us but maintain our ultimate trust in God's providence?
- 11. How can we help each other wait well on God's timing and help each other not waste time on unrighteous pursuits?
