REFLECTING HIS GLORY AS WE GO WITH THE GOSPEL Exodus 34:10-35; 40:34-38

Passage in a Sentence: Exodus begins with Israel groaning for deliverance but ends with Israel seeing the glory of their Deliverer as He dwells with them for their good.

I. CONSIDER GOD'S GRACIOUS RENEWAL

- a. See God's grace in the covenant.
- b. See God's goodness in the covenant.
- c. See God's glory in the covenant.

II. CONSIDER GOD'S GLORY REVEALED AND REFLECTED

- a. As we behold His glory, we will reflect His glory.
- b. No idol will ever give our faces a glorious glow.

III. CONSIDER GOD'S GOODNESS TO REMEMBER

- a. No schemes of the devil and no sins of ours will ultimately stop God from liberating, living with, and leading His people.
- b. We need to set our eyes on God's sufficiency rather than our inadequacies.
- c. Our joy in God is impacted by our obedience to God.
- d. God is present, powerful, pure, and purposeful in His living with and leading us.
- e. Like Israel, we've been set free to serve.
- f. Like Israel, we've been redeemed for relationship.
