



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR ACTS 28:17-31

1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. How are you challenged by Paul's willingness to still share the gospel first with the Jews living in Rome? Is there someone or a group of people with whom you are tempted to stop sharing the gospel?
3. In the final chapters of Acts, how does God use Paul's imprisonment for the good of the gospel? What circumstances is He orchestrating for you to share the gospel in a way you may not have picked for yourself?
4. Though the places and people changed through the Book of Acts, the gospel did not. What should the consistency of the various messengers to faithfully steward the same message teach us about sharing the gospel?
5. In what ways do you need to be better equipped in the Word to proclaim the Kingdom of God and persuade people that Jesus is the Christ?
6. As Acts is brought to a conclusion, how should some receiving the gospel and some rejecting the gospel prepare us for ministry and sharing the gospel in the world?
7. In what ways are you sharing the gospel boldly and in what ways is there a hindrance to your sharing the gospel?
8. Why do you think Luke, under the influence of the Spirit, ends Acts the way he does?
9. How has our study of Acts been helpful for you?
10. How can you contribute this week to fulfilling the mission with which we've been entrusted?
