



Discussion Questions for Matthew 5:31-32

1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. Most people, in some way or another, have been affected by divorce. How have you been affected by divorce?
3. What were you taught about marriage and divorce growing up? Has your view of these topics changed? Why?
4. How can we view marriage as a covenant, not a commodity? What does this look like in your daily life?
5. How do the words of Jesus uphold and honor the importance of marriage? What does the Bible teach about the importance of marriage?
6. Why do we tend to follow culture rather than God's Word on different issues? Why is it important for us to search the Bible and follow what Christ says about different issues?
7. How do the words of Jesus show care for those who were sinned against? Do we, like Jesus, also show the same care for others who sinned against us?
8. For those who are married, how do you ensure that your marriage is strong? For those who are not married, what aspects do you think make a strong marriage?
9. How does this teaching affect the way you view marriage, for those not married?
10. What steps will you take to strengthen your own marriage or help the marriages of those around you?
