- 7. Why should we with a holy vengeance put away anything that pulls us away from Christ? Why are we tempted not to do so?
- 8. In the power of the Gospel, how can we help each other fight for fidelity in our homes and hearts?
- 9. How can we forgive those who wound us deepest by breaking their commitments to us?
- 10. What, if anything, do you need to share with your Connect Group today to find help in the fight for holiness?
