



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR MATTHEW 6:7-15

1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. Why is being able to call God “Father” such a privilege and how can we always strive to appreciate this relationship?
3. Though we are taught to pray to the Father, how are all three members of the Trinity involved in our prayers?
4. How closely do your daily prayers resemble the pattern and content of the Lord’s Prayer? How do we decide when and why we pray?
5. What often takes priority in your prayers? How are God’s priorities reflected in your prayers?
6. How can we learn from this passage without being legalistic about it?
7. Why does God want us to be dependent on Him for daily provision?
8. How do you express your daily dependence on God for food, forgiveness, and faithfulness?
9. Why do we who have been forgiven so much sometimes struggle to forgive others? Why do we need to forgive others and how can God help us to forgive?
10. From whom do you need to seek forgiveness today and to whom do you need to extend forgiveness today?
11. In our daily battle with temptation, why should we make it a priority to ask for God’s protection? How did the Lord help you walk faithfully this past week and how do you need His help this week?
