- 5. Of all the praises that Hannah proclaims of the Lord, which ones stand out in particular to you today?
- 6. Where in your life do you need to rest in the knowledge and strength of the Lord?
- 7. For those who know more of 1 Samuel, how do we see the Lord's plans for Israel play out in Samuel's life?
- 8. In what ways does the passage point us forward to Christ's incarnation and reign?
- 9. In what ways does Christ's priesthood and kingship give us joy this Christmas season?
- 10. How can Hannah's song impact your life this week?
