



Discussion Questions for Luke 1:67-79

1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. What are some of the reasons that Zechariah blesses the Lord in the text? Which reason/reasons resonates with you? Why?
3. Why is it important to remember the promises of God? How does advent remind us to remember those promises?
4. Are you tempted to doubt God's promises? Why or why not? What helps you deal with those times of temptation?
5. We see that Zechariah and Elizabeth were dealing with difficult circumstances in the text and we see that they waited a long time. Is there anything in your life that you are waiting on right now? What are you doing as you wait?
6. Do you know of others who are dealing with difficulties this holiday season? What can you do to encourage them? How does your Connect Group plan on encouraging people this time of year?
7. How can you incorporate celebrating God's faithfulness into this Advent season? What are you doing to show others the faithfulness of God in your life?
8. How does Zechariah's view of the Old Testament help us understand the Old Testament today?
9. Why is it important to remember that we are not just saved from something, but we are saved for something?
10. Would other people say that you are rejoicing because of God's faithfulness? How can we make sure our lives reflect God's faithfulness?
