

## Discussion Questions for Luke 1:46-55

- 1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
- 2. When is a time in your life when your consideration of the Gospel moved you to praise the Lord spontaneously and passionately?
- 3. In what ways are you challenged by Mary's and Joseph's trust in and obedience to the Lord?
- 4. How do you think your trusting in and obeying the Lord is encouraging others?
- 5. If worship surrounds so much of the birth narratives of Jesus in Matthew and Luke, how can we make worshipping Christ a priority in the Christmas season? What are some of the biggest competitors in your heart right now to worshipping Jesus?
- 6. Why does God not want us to "just go through the motions" of worship but for our hearts and heads to both be engaged when expressing praise to the Lord?
- 7. How should we respond knowing God is not just mighty but merciful? Why should we never lose awe in God choosing to be merciful?
- 8. Why is God the only one who can ultimately satisfy the hunger of our souls? How does He satisfy this hunger?
- 9. How can what we see in Luke 1 fuel our confidence God will be faithful to all His promises? What difference should such hope make in our lives on a daily basis? Who is not currently worshiping the Lord but needs you to share the Gospel with them this week?
