



Discussion Questions for Genesis 2:4-17

1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. What are all the ways you can identify God's kindnesses to Adam in Genesis 2:4-14? What do these teach us about God?
3. What is different about the way God formed Adam than the rest of the living creatures? How do we know He was just as precise and caring when He formed us?
4. The greatest blessing in Eden was not the beautiful and delicious provisions but God's presence. How can we sometimes elevate place or provision over God's presence?
5. How is your relationship with God right now?
6. How do we know that "work" is something good and not just a punishment from the curse in Genesis 3? Why do we struggle sometimes to see work as "good"?
7. How are you cultivating and guarding what God has entrusted to you? How can we do our work or school as to the Lord?
8. How is true freedom found in obedience to God rather than disobedience?
9. Why are we so often tempted to pursue life, light, and love where it can never be found (sin)?
10. Why should we view the Bible as the Good Words from our Good Father?
11. Who do you know that is currently living their life as if they will not give an account to the Lord one day? How can you point them toward Christ this week?
