- 7. As those entrusted with dominion, how should we faithfully steward and enjoy God's creation?
- 8. How are you striving to see godly disciples fill Gwinnett, Georgia, and the Globe?
- 9. Why is it significant that Christ is not just *in* God's image, but *is* the image of the invisible God?
- 10. What comfort can we gain in knowing God will one day fully and finally conform us to the image of Christ and that we will never fail to image Him well again?
