- Do you commit to helping our faith family in times of need? (Acts 2:42-47, 4:32-35; James 2:14-17)
- Do you commit to consistently strive to meet the criteria assigned to you in the Word? (1 Tim. 3:1-13; Titus 1:5-9; 1 Pet. 5:1-4)
- Do you commit to pray regularly for the members of Hebron and particularly when they are sick? (James 5:14)

- Do you commit to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ? (Eph. 4:11-13)
- Do you commit to seeking God's will for our church family to the best of your ability by studying the Scriptures and following the Spirit? (Acts 20:28; 1 Pet. 5:1-5)
- Do you commit to set an example and join in fulfilling the duties of church membership? (1 Cor. 11:1; Phil. 3:17; 1 Tim. 4:12)
- Do you commit to shepherd the flock of God that is among you, exercising oversight, not under compulsion, but willingly, as God would have you; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in your charge, but being examples to the flock? (1 Pet. 5:2-3)
- Do you commit to pay careful attention to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to care for the church of God, which he obtained with his own blood? (Acts 20:28)
- Do you commit to keep watch over the souls entrusted to us at Hebron Church, as those who will have to give an account? (Heb. 13:17)
