1. In what way did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. Why did God say it was “not good” for man to be alone?
3. In what ways is marriage meant to be a partnership? For those who are married, in what ways is your spouse your ally?
4. How can we continue to value our spouse and see them as a good gift from the Lord?
5. Second to their relationship with God, why is a marriage relationship meant to be the primary relationship for a husband and wife? What does a married couple need to do to cultivate this primary relationship?
6. Until the death of a spouse, why is marriage meant to be permanent?
7. Why should intimacy in a marriage be both protected and pure? How can we protect marital intimacy?
8. How is a marriage between a man and a woman meant to be a picture of Christ and the Church? How does fulfilling our marital roles ultimately proclaim the Gospel to a watching world?
9. Why is God our only hope for healthy, biblical marriages?
10. How have you seen God’s power displayed in and through your marriage?
