



Discussion Questions for Genesis 3:8-24

1. In what way did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. Why is attempting to conceal our sin from God foolish? What are ways you've attempted to conceal sin in your life?
3. How can we distinguish between the conviction that comes from the Spirit and accusations that come from Satan?
4. When we've committed sin, why should we run to God rather than from Him?
5. What are ways we try to rationalize and excuse our sin rather than take responsibility for it? Whom or what do you tend to blame most for your sin?
6. How can God's care be seen even in consequences we experience because of our disobedience?
7. Why should we be in awe that instead of leaving us in our ruin, God promises to send a Redeemer?
8. What encouragement can we take from God's cursing of the snake and Satan?
9. In what ways have you found work in a fallen world to be difficult?
10. How should we respond to God's covering of Adam and Eve in Genesis 3?
11. How should we respond to God's covering us with Christ's righteousness?
