- 2. Why is attempting to conceal our sin from God foolish? What are ways you've attempted to conceal sin in your life?
- 3. How can we distinguish between the conviction that comes from the Spirit and accusations that come from Satan?
- 4. When we've committed sin, why should we run to God rather than from Him?
- 5. What are ways we try to rationalize and excuse our sin rather than take responsibility for it? Whom or what do you tend to blame most for your sin?
- 6. How can God's care be seen even in consequences we experience because of our disobedience?
- 7. Why should we be in awe that instead of leaving us in our ruin, God promises to send a Redeemer?
- 8. What encouragement can we take from God's cursing of the snake and Satan?
- 9. In what ways have you found work in a fallen world to be difficult?
- 10. How should we respond to God's covering of Adam and Eve in Genesis 3?
- 11. How should we respond to God's covering us with Christ's righteousness?
