6. When, if ever, have you been tempted to doubt God's Word, God's goodness, or God's judgment?
7. Why is all disobedience ultimately fueled by disbelief?
8. In what ways do we try to rationalize our sin?
9. Why is all our sin unreasonable?
10. Who, in our faith family, is loving you genuinely by helping you hate what is evil and cling to what is good? Whom are you loving in these ways?
