1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. In what ways are you most tempted to choose your will over God's revealed will? How has that worked out for you in the past or working out for you now?
3. When is a time your receipt of abundant grace from God did not result in gratitude for or glorifying of God? How can we cultivate gratitude for God as we experience daily goodness from God?
4. When left unchecked, why does sin escalate in our lives rather than dissipate?
5. Why should we be broken by sin rather than boast in it?
6. Why can't all the progress in the world solve our deepest problem?
7. How is the hope and help that comes only from God evident in Genesis 4:25-26?
8. How should our faith in God fuel our gratitude for and glorifying of God?
9. Amid a culture that promotes godless worldliness rather than God-centered worship, why does our faithfulness to God matter?
10. What does your fellowship with and delighting in God look like on a daily basis?
11. How are you striving to leave a legacy of worship rather than worldliness in your family and with those you are discipling?
12. How are you striving to help others walk in and with God rather than walk away from Him?
