Passage in a Sentence: By God's grace and for the good of the Gospel and the good of our children and our children's children, walk with the Lord and not away from Him.

I. By God's grace, do not walk in the ways of the rebellious.

- a. Avoid the descent of depravity.
 - i. Choosing self-will over God's will
 - ii. Receiving abundant grace but having no gratitude for or glorifying of Christ
 - iii. Boasting in sin rather than being broken by it
 - iv. Failing to recognize all the progress in the world cannot solve our deepest problem

II. By God's grace, walk in the ways of the righteous.

- a. Advance the development of disciples
 - i. Having Faith in God
 - 1. A faith made possible by God
 - 2. A faith preserved by God
 - ii. Being Faithful to God
 - 1. Practicing righteousness
 - 2. Prophesying against rebellion
 - 3. Proclaiming relief
 - iii. Enjoying Fellowship with God
 - 1. Devoted to and delighting in God
 - 2. A legacy of worship rather than worldliness
