

Discussion Questions for Genesis 6:1-8:19

- 1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
- 2. What does this passage teach us about the character of God?
- 3. What does this passage teach us about sin? What are ways that sinful decisions have negatively affected you or someone close to you?
- 4. How does this passage connect to the passage of Scripture we studied last week? Are there similar themes mentioned? Why is it important for us to keep the context of Scripture in mind as we study?
- 5. What do we learn about Noah in Genesis 6:8-9? What do these passages teach us about how we relate to God? What can we learn about Noah from Hebrews 11:7?
- 6. What do we learn about Noah's obedience in this text? How do we see the connection between righteousness and obedience? How does this text shape your view of obedience?
- 7. Are there areas of your life where you are hesitant to obey the Lord? Why or why not? If you have struggled to obey the Lord in the past, what helps you obey Him today?
- 8. What can we learn about God's salvation from the Ark? (See 7:1, 7:16, 7:23, 8:16)
- 9. When was a time that you had to wait on the Lord? How did you respond when you were asked to wait on the Lord? What can we learn about waiting on the Lord from Genesis 8?
- 10. How was this passage of Scripture comforting to the Israelites who have been wandering in the desert and are getting ready to enter the promised land? What comfort do you find in this passage of Scripture?
