- 3. Why should we be amazed at God's gracious plan to bless the nations in Christ? Why should we be amazed at God's gracious plan to bless us in Christ?
- 4. Why is the Gospel not about our "deserving" but God's determination to have a people for His praise?
- 5. How should we be challenged by Abram's faith and faithfulness to receive and respond to God's call on His life?
- 6. How can God's promises fuel our obedience? How are they fueling your obedience?
- 7. Why do we sometimes struggle to believe God's promises? How can we live faithfully while waiting to experience the full blessing of God's promises?
- 8. As you reflect on your life, when are seasons of preparation for God's purposes that can be identified though you may not have recognized them at the time?
- 9. Why should we be challenged by Abram's proclaiming and praising of God in Canaan?
- 10. How are God's blessings to you fueling your being a gospel blessing to others?
