



Discussion Questions for Genesis 12:1-9

1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. Why is Genesis 12:1-9 more about what God is doing and not just about what Abram is doing?
3. Why should we be amazed at God's gracious plan to bless the nations in Christ? Why should we be amazed at God's gracious plan to bless us in Christ?
4. Why is the Gospel not about our "deserving" but God's determination to have a people for His praise?
5. How should we be challenged by Abram's faith and faithfulness to receive and respond to God's call on His life?
6. How can God's promises fuel our obedience? How are they fueling your obedience?
7. Why do we sometimes struggle to believe God's promises? How can we live faithfully while waiting to experience the full blessing of God's promises?
8. As you reflect on your life, when are seasons of preparation for God's purposes that can be identified though you may not have recognized them at the time?
9. Why should we be challenged by Abram's proclaiming and praising of God in Canaan?
10. How are God's blessings to you fueling your being a gospel blessing to others?
