



### **Discussion Questions for John 11:1-45**

1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. When is a time, like Mary and Martha, you had a plan for how you wanted things to go, but Jesus had a better plan?
3. When Jesus doesn't work in the way we want Him to work or in the time we want Him to work, why are we tempted to doubt His love for us?
4. When was a time that God's "delay" served to further develop your faith in Him rather than your distrust of Him?
5. How is Jesus glorified through the raising of Lazarus from the dead rather than just healing him from sickness? How is He glorified in your circumstances?
6. What does it mean for Jesus to be the resurrection and life? Why does He want us to see He is the resurrection and not just believe in a resurrection?
7. For whom is Jesus the resurrection and life? What does it mean to believe in Him?
8. Even when we face physical death, why can we still have hope?
9. If our fear of death has been taken away, what implications does this have for us regarding living for the sake of the Gospel?
10. With whom do you need to share the Gospel this week?
11. Why should we celebrate Christ's life, death, and resurrection every week? How will you do so this week?
