- 4. What is it about trials that can tempt us to forget God's presence and promises?
- 5. How can remembering God's presence and promises help us to act faithfully during trials?
- 6. When is a time during a trial you think you acted fearfully rather than faithfully?
- 7. What comfort can we take in God's providence over both the trials we face and even our acting unfaithfully in some of those trials?
- 8. As we see God protect and provide for Sarai and Abram, how should His actions produce humility and hope in our hearts?
- 9. What, if any, trial are you currently facing for which we can pray for you and help you fight for faithfulness?
- 10. How do you think God wants to use trials you're facing to advance His Gospel in and through you this week?
