4. What is it about trials that can tempt us to forget God's presence and promises?
5. How can remembering God's presence and promises help us to act faithfully during trials?
6. When is a time during a trial you think you acted fearfully rather than faithfully?
7. What comfort can we take in God's providence over both the trials we face and even our acting unfaithfully in some of those trials?
8. As we see God protect and provide for Sarai and Abram, how should His actions produce humility and hope in our hearts?
9. What, if any, trial are you currently facing for which we can pray for you and help you fight for faithfulness?
10. How do you think God wants to use trials you're facing to advance His Gospel in and through you this week?
