



### **Discussion Questions for Genesis 13**

1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. When we've failed God, why are we tempted to run from God rather than to Him?
3. When we've disobeyed the Lord, how can we and why should we run to Him?
4. When considering conflict with others, what can we learn from how Abram handled the situation with Lot? When have you been tempted to value your rights more than valuing reconciliation?
5. How did Abram's offer and Lot's choice reveal their attitudes toward wealth? How should grace make us generous toward others and with all the Lord has entrusted to us?
6. When faced with choices, how have you been tempted to decide based on sight rather than seeking the Lord's counsel? How did it work out?
7. What can we learn from Lot's decision to move closer to Sodom? In what ways, are you currently tempted to move toward worldliness rather than godliness?
8. How can Spirit-empowered conviction help us minimize compromise with the world? How can we cultivate Spirit-empowered conviction?
9. How was Abram's trust in the Lord rewarded in the last portion of Genesis 13? How have you seen your trust rewarded?
10. How is Abram a model of trusting in the Lord's promises even though they were not immediately fulfilled? What, if anything, is tempting you not to trust God's promises today?
