

## **Discussion Questions for Genesis 13**

- 1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
- 2. When we've failed God, why are we tempted to run from God rather than to Him?
- 3. When we've disobeyed the Lord, how can we and why should we run to Him?
- 4. When considering conflict with others, what can we learn from how Abram handled the situation with Lot? When have you been tempted to value your rights more than valuing reconciliation?
- 5. How did Abram's offer and Lot's choice reveal their attitudes toward wealth? How should grace make us generous toward others and with all the Lord has entrusted to us?
- 6. When faced with choices, how have you been tempted to decide based on sight rather than seeking the Lord's counsel? How did it work out?
- 7. What can we learn from Lot's decision to move closer to Sodom? In what ways, are you currently tempted to move toward worldliness rather than godliness?
- 8. How can Spirit-empowered conviction help us minimize compromise with the world? How can we cultivate Spirit-empowered conviction?
- 9. How was Abram's trust in the Lord rewarded in the last portion of Genesis 13? How have you seen your trust rewarded?
- 10. How is Abram a model of trusting in the Lord's promises even though they were not immediately fulfilled? What, if anything, is tempting you not to trust God's promises today?
