

Discussion Questions for Genesis 17

- 1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
- 2. Why is it merciful for God to continue to reveal himself to Abram? What areas of your life do you see evidence of God's mercy?
- 3. What is the Lord teaching Abraham about waiting on Him? What has God been teaching you about waiting on Him?
- 4. What is meant by "progressive revelation" in Scripture? Why is it important to note God doesn't change; however, He does reveal Himself more clearly to His people throughout the Scripture?
- 5. What does the Bible tell us about circumcision of the heart? (See Deuteronomy 10:16, Jeremiah 4:4, Romans 2:29, Colossians 2:11) What does it mean to have our hearts circumcised? Why does this matter for believers?
- 6. Why does God keep reminding Abram about the covenant He made with Abraham? What can we learn from God's repetition?
- 7. What can we learn about the name changes in the text? Why is it meaningful that God changed the names of Abram and Sarai to Abraham and Sarah?
- 8. Share about a time when you have been guilty of giving suggestions to God as Abraham did in the text (Genesis 17:18)? How does God's sovereignty override our suggestions?
- 9. How does Abraham respond to God's instructions? What does Abraham's response teach us about obedience?
- 10. Have you ever been guilty of not obeying God or not obeying God immediately? How did that work out for you? How does obedience show our faith?
